RECOUNT DAY 1: Thursday, December 1, 2016

The following persons were present:

The Recount was called to order at 9:00 a.m. at the Town of Washington Municipal Complex, 5750 Old Town Hall Road in Eau Claire, Wisconsin, to conduct an Election Recount of the November 8, 2016, General Election for the office of President/Vice President. The notice was posted on Monday, November 28, 2016. The BOC did make the decision that all ballots would be hand counted.

It is noted that we have on file a copy of the Order For Recount filed by Jill Stein that had been filed with the Wisconsin Elections Commission.

County Clerk Janet K. Loomis welcomed everyone and explained the processes that would take place for the Recount. The Board of Canvass (BOC) and the candidate representative would be the only persons allowed to address the Board of Canvass with challenges. Ground rules were explained; tabulators and observers were reminded to sign in and sign out during the day. Loomis explained the workstations, which included areas for poll book reconciliation, tabulating touch screen votes, ballot review, absentee ballot envelope review application/certification, and then hand counting the ballots.

Recount Process

The Recount began, and the procedures listed below were followed for each of the reporting units in Eau Claire County for the President/Vice President race. Five workstations were set up and two reporting units were worked on at a time.

1. **Poll book reconciliation:** Two tabulators reconciled both poll books and supplemental poll lists to confirm that the same total number of electors matched in both poll books. The tabulators determined from the poll list the total number of voters and the number of absentee voters recorded. Notes were made to document differences encountered while going through the poll books. The county clerk publicly announced Recount reconciliations compared to the number of voters for each reporting unit as listed on Election Day Inspectors Statements.
2. **Absentee ballot applications/certifications:** The BOC reviewed the absentee ballot applications/certifications for voters' signatures and witness signatures, and then the envelopes were counted twice in stacks of twenty-five and compared with the number of absentee voters listed in the poll books and on Inspectors Statements. Rejected absentee envelopes that had been rejected on Election Day were reviewed and no rejected absentee envelopes were deemed by the BOC to be counted during the Recount. If an absentee/certification had been counted on Election Day, but the BOC had set it aside for not being complete, it has been noted in the "Notes" section of these minutes for each reporting unit. The county clerk publicly announced the total number of absentee envelopes and this number was compared to the poll book.
3. **DRE (Direct Record Electronic – EDGE) ballots:** The DRE ballots (produced by touchscreen voting machines) are contained on a paper roll, so they were unrolled and two tabulators looked at the ballot and one tabulator read aloud the candidate's name on the ballot. Then it was tallied by two tabulators. The Recount for the touchscreen ballots took place in a location where the public could view the paper roll that showed the DRE ballot. When complete, both tabulators added the votes. The county clerk publicly announced the totals from the Recount tallies and the Election Day votes.
4. **Ballots and ballot bags** The tabulators examined the ballot bags for signs of tampering to ensure that they had not been previously opened, and then compared the seal numbers to the seal numbers recorded on the Inspectors Statements. They

opened the ballot bags and removed the contents, separated ballots by reporting unit (if a polling place had multiple reporting units). Then ballots were separated by candidate and two tabulators counted ballot piles of twenty-five and stacks of one hundred, and absentees were identified and separated by candidate. All ballots were publicly reviewed by a tabulator turning each ballot over in a public setting. Observers were allowed to have questionable ballots set aside for BOC review to determine voter intent, even though a voter may not have marked the ballot correctly so that the voting machine may not have counted it for that candidate. Because all ballots were hand counted during the Recount, the BOC made determinations of voter intent, and ballots were placed in the respective candidate's pile. If ballots had been set aside for review due to poll workers initials missing and total number of voters on the poll list matched the total number of ballots cast, no ballots were deemed defective. The total number of ballots in the Recount was compared to the Election Day number of ballots and number of voters listed on the poll list. If any discrepancies existed, they were noted in the "Notes" section below each reporting unit's information. Tabulators counted the ballots per candidate, and then the county clerk publicly announced the totals from Recount tallies and the Election Day votes as stated on the attached original canvass and the Recount Canvass report that is attached to these minutes. Once the county clerk announced that the reporting unit was complete in Recount, the tabulators placed the ballots back in the ballot bag and resealed it, and the seal number from the Recount was recorded.

5. **Provisional ballots:** The BOC examined the Inspectors Certificate of Provisional Ballots and the Provisional Ballot Certificate envelopes, and the provisional ballot bag was opened and the voter's choice of candidate was added into the recount totals. If a municipality had a provisional ballot counted, it will be noted in the "Notes" section in the reporting unit's information.
6. **Recount canvas:** A recount canvas report with vote totals per candidate and per municipality is included here in Exhibit 10.

-During the recount tabulators counted only 200 ballots; County Clerk Janet K. Loomis contacted the Village Clerk that evening and asked her to check the ballot bin from

Election Day. The next morning, the Village Clerk called the County Clerk to say she found a ballot in the write-in bin that had not been removed on Election Day. The County Clerk asked her to seal the ballot in a ballot bag. The County Clerk sent Deputy County Clerk Sue McDonald to pick it up and bring to the Recount location. Sue McDonald returned at 10:30 a.m. on Friday, December 2 with the ballot bag. Recount tabulators opened the bag and this ballot was marked with a write-in, but not a registered write-in candidate's name was written. All ballots have been accounted for the Village of Fairchild in Recount.

-There were five in-person absentee Application/Certification envelopes that did not have Clerk or Deputy Clerk's signature. The BOC decided that it was an error on the Clerk and that if she would make a statement that these people did absentee vote at the town hall, the BOC would accept these absentee voters. The County Clerk contacted the Town of Seymour Clerk, Sue Larson, on Friday, December 2 and she came to the Town of Washington and signed a statement, which is Exhibit 1.

-The differences in votes cast for candidates from Election Day results were due to voters did not mark their ballots correctly by connecting the arrows next to the candidate of choice; therefore, on Election Day, the machine may have counted ballots as undervotes or overvotes.

-Two voters wrote in Hillary Clinton for President in the write-in section and the Town of Washington poll workers did account for one of those votes on Election Night by hand changing the total tape but not the other.

-On the optical scan voting machine for Election Day, the results tape listed 4,404 ballots cast but should be 4,403 per Town of Washington Clerk Janelle Henning. She stated that an absentee ballot on Election Day, when putting it in the Optec machine, came between the ballot bin and the underneath of the Optec machine instead of into the ballot bin.

They thought it had not been counted, so they put it in the machine again, which resulted in it being counted twice. There is no way to identify that ballot, but it was only counted once during the Recount.

-In Recount, there were 32 write-in ballots for McMullin and on Election Day poll workers tallied 22 for McMullin

-One provisional ballot was added into the Recount numbers, but this provisional ballot was in the original canvas
